All that you have to do is go to Hulu.com and start searching for movies, shows, and clips to watch from your PC, TV, mobile phone or tablet. There's no obligation or signing in. Although, if you create a free account you can create an online queue of your favorite movies and TV shows.

## How To Permanently Delete Your Facebook Account

Many of you may be aware that you can deactivate your Facebook account at any time, but did you know that it is not permanently gone from the Facebook servers?

That's right, to simply deactivate your Facebook account, log into your Facebook account then click on the "Account" tab in the upper-right side of the screen, then under the "Settings" tab at the bottom you will find the "Deactivate Account" option. What happens when you deactivate your account is that the user is taken off Community pages, photos tagged with you are de-tagged and status updates or other information posted to your own page are taken down. Posts on friends' walls remain, but your name appears in unclickable text. Although you may be absent from Facebook, all of your information remains!!!!.



That's right, they keep your entire account on their servers should you ever decide to return. If you do make the decision to come back all you have to do is simply log back in with your username and password and everything is still there as if you never left. There is no time limit on how long your Facebook account can be deactivated.

However, if you decide that **you want to be permanently removed from Facebook** there is a way but it's a little trickier. You have to find the Help Center and search for the "delete" option (I have a direct link to this option at the bottom of the article). What happens when you choose this option is that they ask "Are you sure you want to permanently removed from the site and that the action cannot be reversed". If you choose to proceed they make a last-ditch effort to change your mind by naming some of your Facebook friends and telling you that they will miss you if you leave. Once you have deleted your account they give you 14 days to change your mind, then after that it is removed from the Facebook site permanently.

For the hyperlink below to work properly you must first log into your Facebook account then **paste the link into a new browser**.
